Associate Professor Parker is an internationally recognised specialist in disorders and surgery of the knee joint. He has particular interests in computer assisted and robotic knee replacement surgery, sports injuries and ligament reconstruction surgery, as well as surgery to realign and restore the knee joint. His elective surgical practice focuses exclusively on the knee joint, as well as a strong interest in nonsurgical management of knee arthritis. He completed his orthopaedic training in Sydney and spent 2 years studying overseas in world-renowned institutions to further his knowledge and training, specifically in the area of knee surgery. He began practice in Sydney in late 2001.

Having established the Sydney Orthopaedic Research Institute in 2002, Associate Professor Parker has subsequently become known internationally for his research into surgery of the knee joint. He has given over 200 original research presentations and invited presentations at national and international conferences. He has over 140 publications in prestigious peer-reviewed journals, plus multiple chapters for orthopaedic textbooks. He is on the editorial board for several journals including JISAKOS, AJSM, OJSM, and AP-SMART. He was awarded the AOA prize for services to orthopaedic research in 2021.
